President's Message

By now you know I research and read other Christian resources and websites. Since the Council is preparing for a leadership retreat in May, I looked up the 2020 Leadership Conference on Right Now Media. The theme for this conference is Focus: Focus on The Master, Focus on The Message, Focus on The Mission.

The session I want to share with you is Get Up and Go by Bianca Juarez Olthoff, lead pastor at The Fathers House Church in Orange Co, California. Pastor Bianca said that we need to focus on listening to the Triune God. During these difficult times, her prayer is that we don't listen to the negative voices but listen to the voice of the Spirit of God.

Her testimony is she has been a Christian all her life. Her father is a pastor and she and her husband co-pastor a church. Even with all this she felt empty. She had all the information about God but wanted revelation, victory and truth. She wanted to know how to use the gift God gave her.

She went on to say, we need the Spirit of God to be alive and active in our lives. We have been anesthetized to doing things how we do them every day. Jesus wants to rescue us from our religiosity, our dusty, boring lives and revive us anew. We are not defined by our failures. Our anxiety of the virus and political times. Our feelings of loss of job or relationships. We are children of the everlasting God.

Her session title comes from Acts 9 where Jesus called Paul to evangelize and minister to the gentile world. That's us! Paul answered the call of God not knowing what was next. Not knowing he would write 2/3 of New Testament. Acts 9:6 tells us Jesus said "But rise and enter the city, and you will be told what you are to do." Those are the action points that Jesus has for us to follow his call: Get back up; get up and go; You will be told what to do.

On January 17th, Pastor Dan taught us about God's Call in our lives. He knows what he is talking about since he recently faithfully followed God's Call to Trinity. What immediate call is God putting on your life and ministry? Do you sense the Holy Spirit's whisper asking you to do something in your life?

What about his call seems too big or unachievable for you to accomplish? What can you do to trust God more fully as you follow his calling?

The good news is the Holy Spirit will not ask us to do anything, he won't provide for. Jesus told the disciples when he sent them out into the ministry field, not to be anxious because they would be told what to say. "If the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit who dwells in you." Romans 8:11 ESV

If we do things that we can do - we get the glory, but if we do things that we are incapable of doing we need to trust God to empower us so He gets the glory. Charles Spurgeon, the famous 19th century preacher said "many have come through Calvary, but not through Pentecost. We have become butterflies when God wants us to be eagles."

Pastor Bianco reminded us "If you ain't dead God isn't done with you". There is work to be done in our church, our community, our schools and our families. I pray that you will join me in listening to the voice of Jesus as He shows us what He wants us to do. If Jesus is revealing new things to you please share them with us. May the same Holy Spirit that empowered the early church, revive us to do God's will.
