Gelene and I pray that you will have a blessed New Year.



#### **Letter From Trinity President**

The Women of Trinity and the Men's Ministry Team of Trinity were busy setting up and getting ready for Birchwood's annual Christmas Fest.


The Men's Ministry assisted the vendors with set-up while the Women of Trinity sold Chili, cornbread and bars
